Hospice Fall Volunteer Training

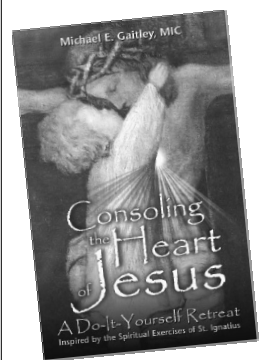
