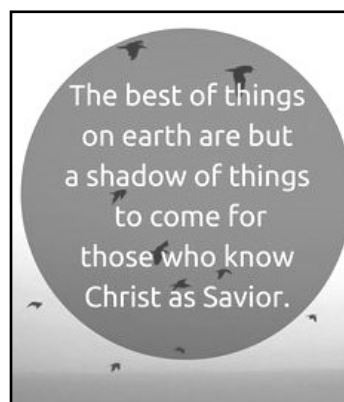

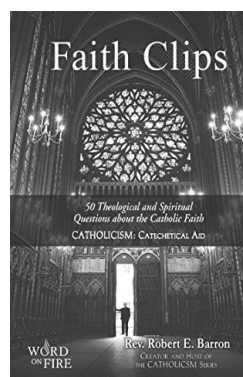

### SAFETY TIP of THE WEEK - PARKING RULES

The lower and upper parking lots are striped to indicate available spots for parking, including ones closest to the Church building for handicap-accessibility. **AT NO TIME** should anyone be parking "three deep" on the lower lot. Parking is also not allowed between the end of the lined spots and the grass on the edge of the lot, as this lane must be kept available for **official emergency vehicles**, i.e. ambulance or fire truck.
