The Religious Education Program has been very busy thus far. On Saturday October 14th we held our Youth Mass followed by a bake sale. Proceeds from the sale went to our Pantry. We collected \$200.00 for the pantry.

I attended the Catechetical Forum that was held in Monroe on October 28th, from 10a-4p.

The Level 7 Confirmation Class participated in their required Retreat on Saturday October 28 from 7:00-8:30 pm at Our LADY OF Mount Carmel. The Guest Speaker for the evening was Frank Runion. He spoke to the children on the Topic Hollywood vs. Faith. He was wonderful and hit on all topic areas for the children's level on how magazines, celebrities, and movies and commercials poison the minds of children and adults as well, and how we should try and deal with real life and not try to use Hollywood as a guide. It was an excellent presentation.

On November 4th, from 2:30-5:00p, we held our Family Catechesis. The topic for the afternoon was learning about Saint Francis Xavier Mother Cabrini. The children also decorated the boxes for the food pantry clients, as well as a card to present to the families. The children also enjoyed the snacks of candied apples, cider and cinnamon sugared donuts. This was followed by a Youth Mass at 5:30pm. They all had a great time.
