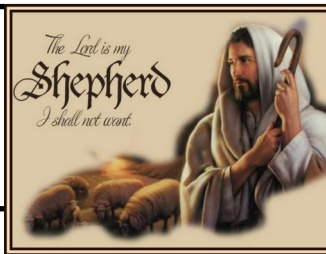

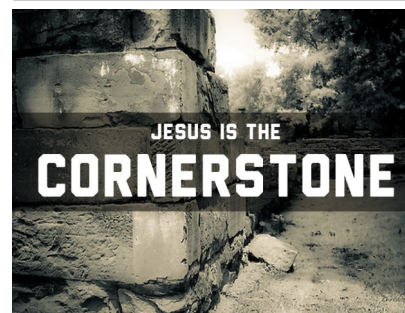

*Jesus call us by name, because
 He knows us like no one else knows us.*

The Gospel today speaks of Jesus being in the temple for the Feast of Dedication. One of the Scripture passages proclaimed during that feast was taken from Ezekiel the Prophet, and it was the passage that proclaimed God as our shepherd. When Jesus spoke of himself being the Good Shepherd, he was applying that prophecy to himself. He speaks in tremendously affectionate terms of His care and concern for His beloved flock. He will give His life for us. He will protect us from all dangers (especially the dangers of sin and death and alienation.)

"How to Diffuse a Bomb" starring Denis P. Mulcahy

This Irish documentary follows the story of *Project Children*, an organization established in 1975 by NYPD bomb squad member Denis Mul-

cahy. *Denis just happens to be the 1st cousin of our own Sean Moriarty and is a well-known member of the greater Orange County community!*

The film looks back at the work of the Project Children organization founded by Denis that allowed over 23,000 children from Catholic and Protestant backgrounds to escape the "The Troubles" and live together in the United States over the course of a summer. The children's summer project ran for 40 years before finishing last year. The organization's internship program, established in 1995, continues to bring students to the US to live and work. This documentary, narrated by Liam Neeson, broadcast on BBC Northern Ireland in December 2017.

The Hurleyville Arts Centre will feature a showing of the documentary this Friday, April 27 at 6:30 PM, followed by a Q&A session with Denis Mulcahy. Upcoming Improvements

A number of projects are being planned for the near future, paid for with your generous donations to Renew & Rebuild. Here are some highlights:

- ◆ **Parish Center** — Establish drainage on the front right corner of the Parish Center to eliminate water seeping through the foundation into the Chapel area.
- ◆ **Parking Lot Plans** — Make modifications to the lower and upper Church parking lots to create better drainage (and reduce ice build-up); add a sidewalk adjacent to the Church connecting the rear entry with the ramp; expand the upper lot to its full potential to add parking spaces; put up a fence between the Restoration Church and our lot plus one at the end of the lot to establish property boundaries; install a chain across the entry to the upper lot to keep it for use for Church activity only; repave and restripe both lots. And there's more, but these are our first priority.

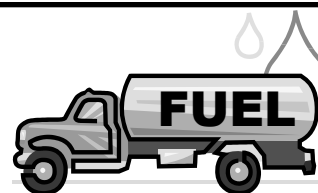
