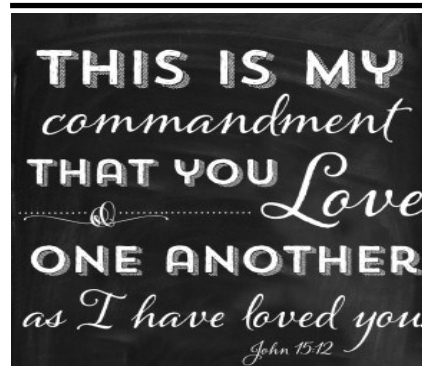

Relax! God put the wiggle in children. Don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome!

Sit toward the front where it is easier for your little ones to see and hear what's going on. They tire of seeing the back of others' heads.

Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and actions of the Priest, Altar Servers, Ushers, Eucharistic Ministers, Lectors, Choir, etc.

Sing the hymns, pray, and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.

If you have to leave the Mass with your child for any reason, feel free to do so — but please come back! As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me."

Remember that the way we welcome our children in Church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God, and to one another. Let them know they are at home in this house of worship.
