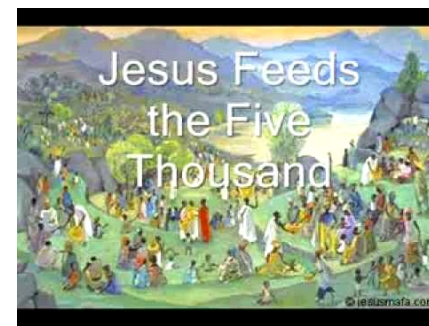

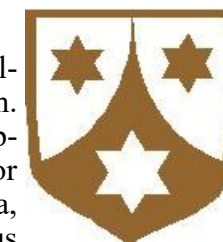


### Monthly Healing Mass

Your cooperation is both needed and appreciated, to maintain the safety of our Church and our parishioners!

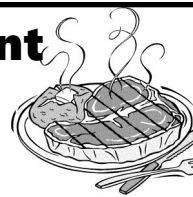
