Isaiah 35:4-7a James 2:1-5 Mark 7:31-37

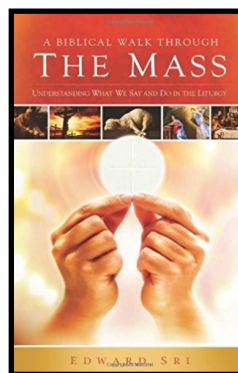
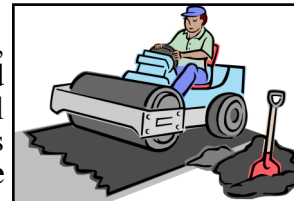

Program at Infant Savior

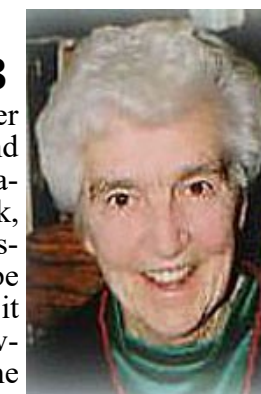
