This image is used in the Book of Revelation where a sword comes from the mouth of Jesus (his word) and the Gospel of Luke where Mary is told a sword would pierce her heart. (In the Bible, the heart is where one thinks). God's word would pierce her thoughts to help her believe what was impossible: that her Son was the Son of God.

### Variety Show This Sunday!

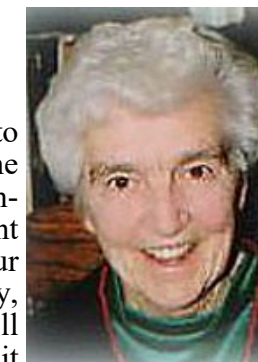
