Isaiah 53:10-11
Hebrews 4:14-16
Mark 10:35-45

Got Tickets?

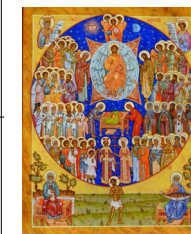
