There are times in our lives when we must speak up and even shake things up for the sake of God's truth and love.

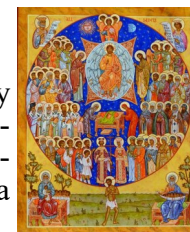

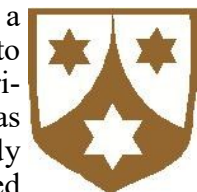
Thanksgiving Baskets
