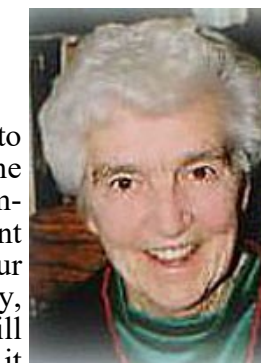


Called to be Holy

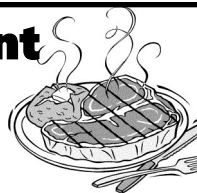
