Religious Education Collection for People in Need

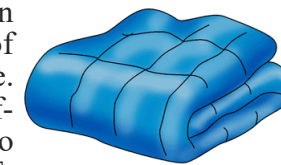

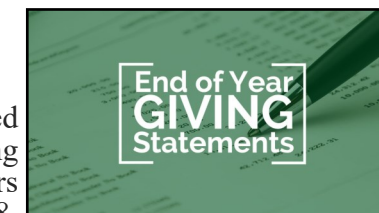
Women's Retreat
