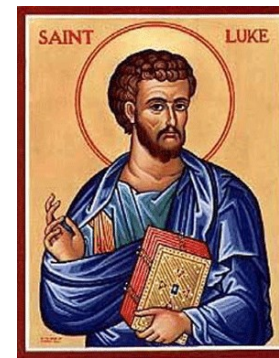

and we are parts of that body.*

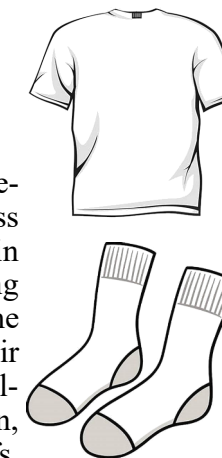

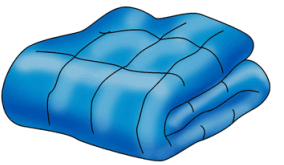

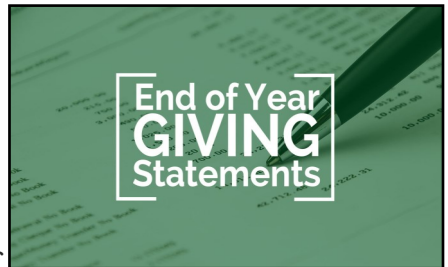


### Women's Retreat
