### Today's Scripture

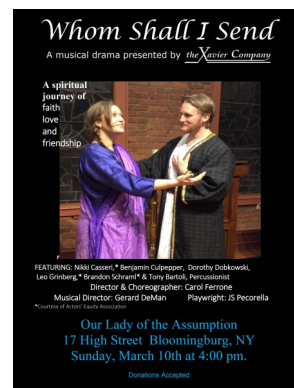
Isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8

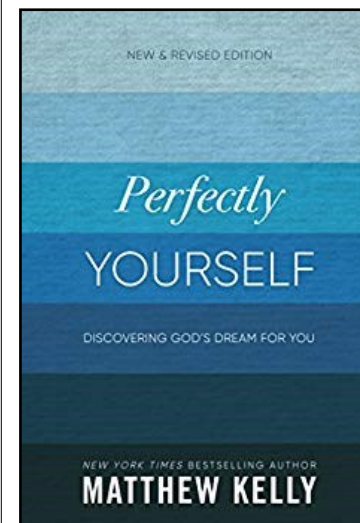
### Volunteer Needed
