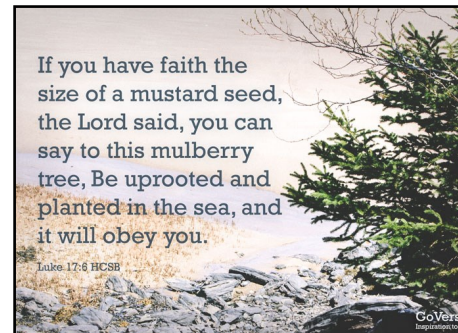

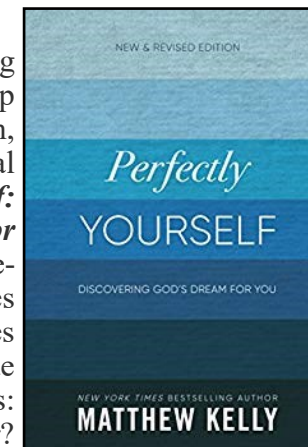


It Is Beginning!

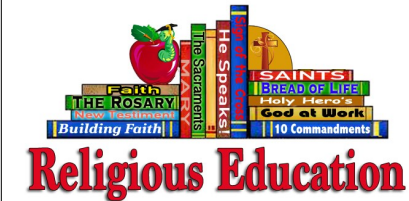
Lenten Study
