The second Adam, Jesus, has brought life into the world. Unlike the first Adam, he was obedient to the command of his Father.

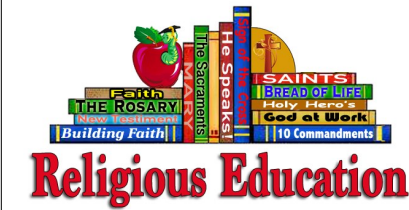
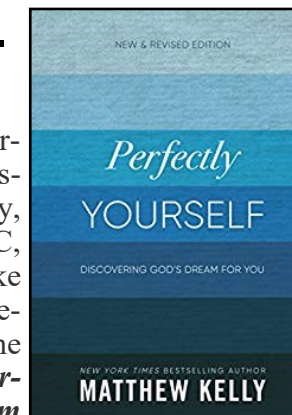
While we have inherited our earthly nature and sin from the first Adam, we have inherited our spiritual nature and eternal life from Jesus.

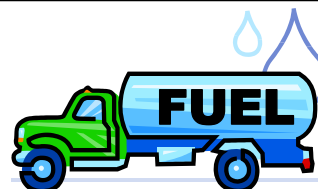
