Today's Scripture

love is PATIENT,
love is kind.
it does not envy,
it does not boast.
it is not proud.
1 Corinthians 13:4

Jeremiah 1:
4-5, 17-19
1 Corinthians 13:

Luke 4:21-30

Love should be the measure of all that we do.

This statement is especially important for us today, for the word "love" has been misused by our society, in today's Letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul is not speaking about affection, or sexual attraction, or neediness, or any other ideas that are called "love" today. He is speaking about the willingness to serve as an examination of conscience to help us determine whether our actions and attitudes are really based upon love.

Toward the end of the reading, Paul speaks of his former attitude (that of a child). By this he means that he once thought only of himself (he is speaking of the selfishness that children can sometimes display.) Now he has learned to be generous and think more of others than of himself. This is what heaven means; not being concerned with ourselves, but being a totally giving person for all eternity.

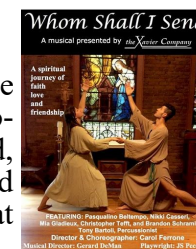


Youth Mass & Bake Sale

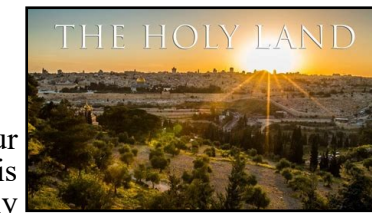
"Whom Shall I Send"
