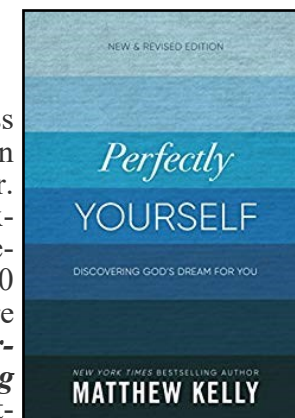

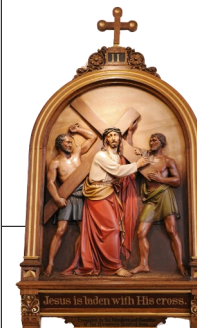
Book Discussion Begins Thursday
