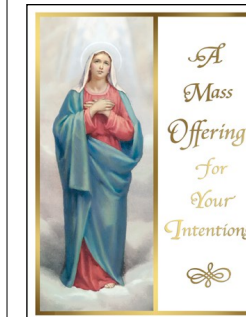


First Friday Holy Hour with Exposition
