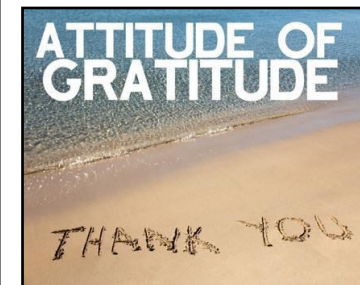


Sunday, May 12
