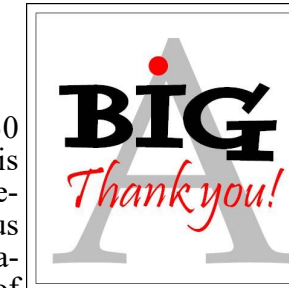

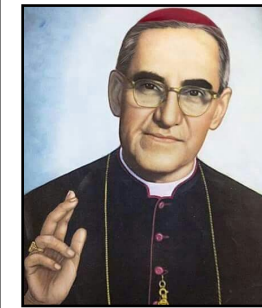


Memorial Day Flag Ceremony
