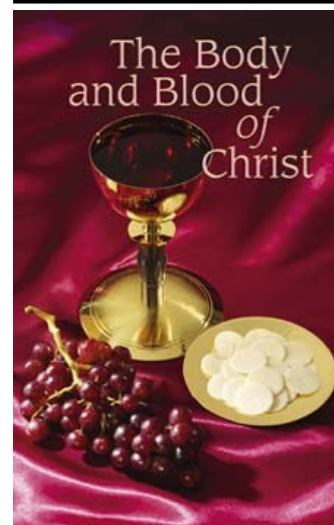

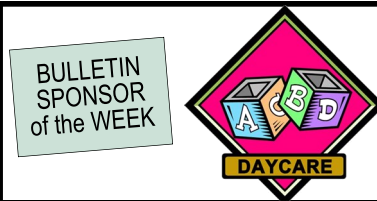


◆◆ Parish Office News ◆◆
