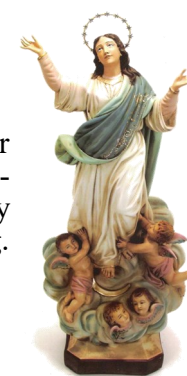
FRIDAY AUGUST 23 at The Eagle's Nest

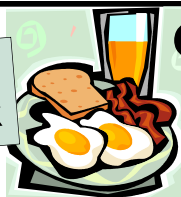
