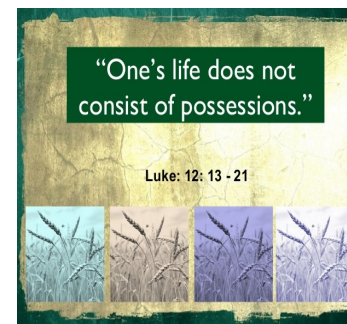

### Today's Scripture

Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23  
 Colossians 3:1-5, 9-11  
 Luke 12:13-21

Father Paul will administer this important, and often misunderstood sacrament of healing to those who come forward immediately following the 9:30 AM Mass.

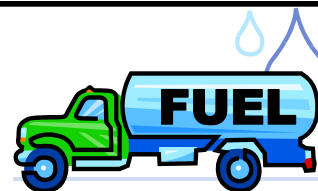
