*Everything that happens to us should be one more opportunity for us to share God's love.*

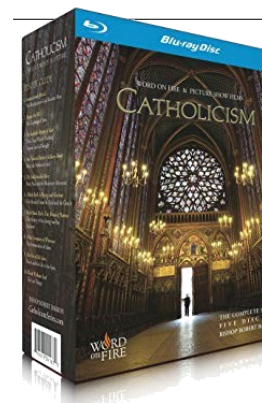
