### The Year of Vocations

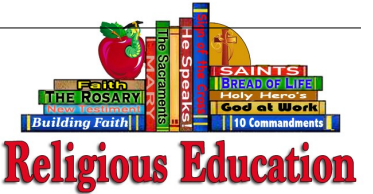

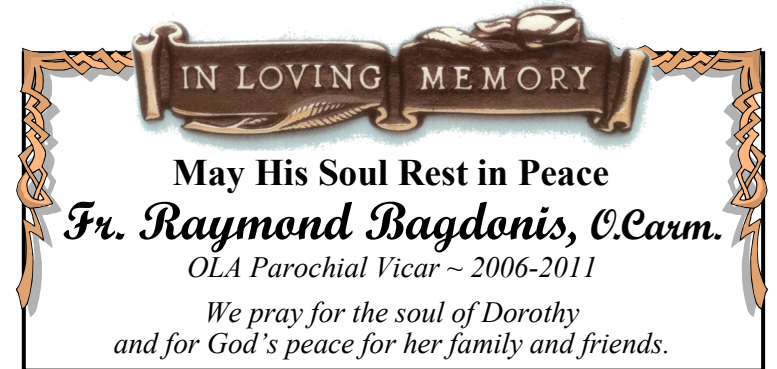
### Meeting on Nov. 20
