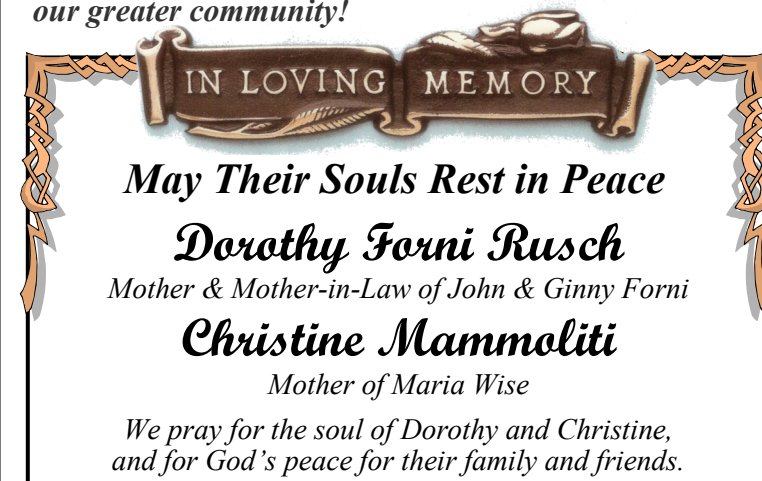
Thanksgiving Baskets
