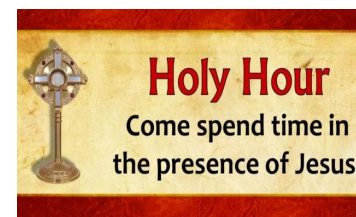
Important Meeting

annual fundraiser so that it can be as successful as it has been — raising more than \$10,000 that can be used for Parish operations and programs.

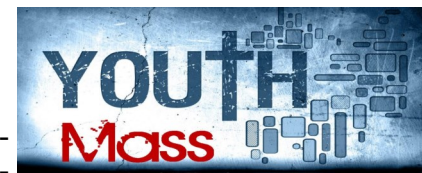
