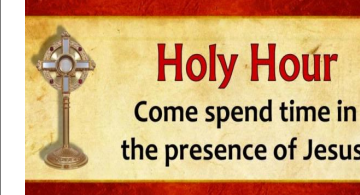


The Year of Vocations
