30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Exodus 22:20-26
II Thessalonians 1:5c-10
Matthew 22: 34-40

How can we tell whether our faith is an expression of love for God? It is that we keep the word of God and make it alive every day of our lives.

There are times in our lives when everything seems to be changing all at once. Things that we thought would always be one way change radically. Where are things going to find a sense of security and stability?

Today's psalm responds that the only true source of stability in our lives is God. He is our rock and fortress. When we are shaken by the waves of misfortune and confusion, God is there to give us a moral compass. He protects us from everything that could harm us.

This does not mean that things always end up well. Bad things happen. And there is much suffering in life. But if God is the foundation of our life and faith, then we can be able to get through whatever happens.
