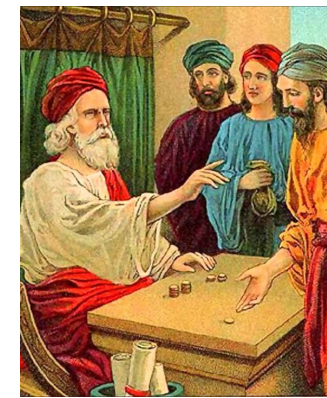

Proverbs 31:

In the early Church, there was a belief that Jesus would return in glory within a short while. St. Paul, in fact, recommended to the Corinthians that they not get married because the end of the world was near.

But when the end of the world failed to appear, people began to believe that maybe the return of Jesus would not happen immediately. Nevertheless, it was important that people be ready for it whenever it might occur. They began speaking of it occurring unannounced, like a thief in the night. They would not know when, but they always should be ready.
