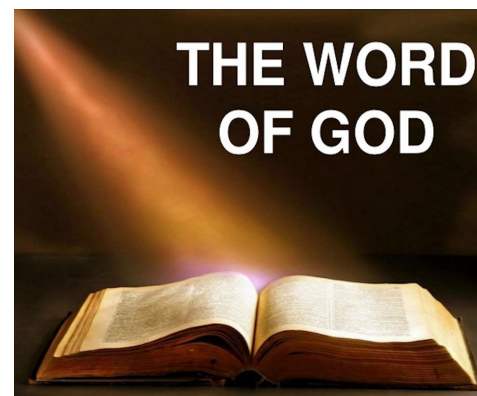

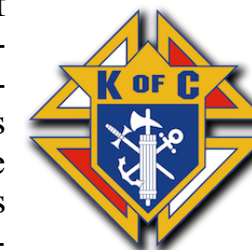

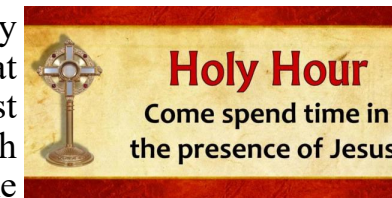


Scholarship Offered
