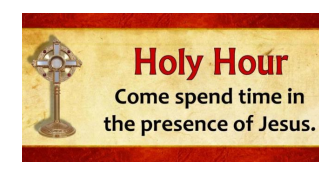

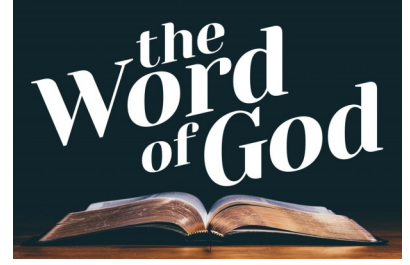

Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40
 Romans 8:14-17
 Matthew 28: 16-20

We give praise to God who is three persons in one God. This truth was revealed to us through the life and ministry of Jesus.

The Spirit of God was breathed into us when God created Adam. That same Spirit was breathed into the disciples on the day of the resurrection (Gospel of John) or Pentecost (Acts of the Apostles).

This Spirit reminds us that we have God's own breath inside of us. That breath gives voice to the fact that God is our own Father and Jesus is our brother. We must share both his sufferings (when we carry our own crosses) and his glory.
