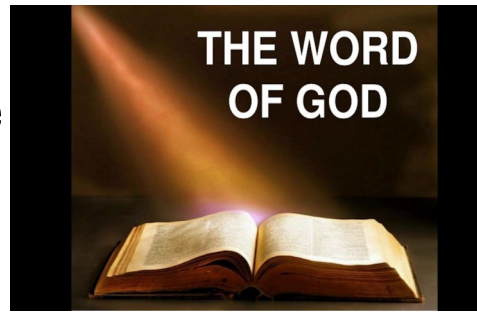

Amos 7:12-15 Ephesians 1:3-14

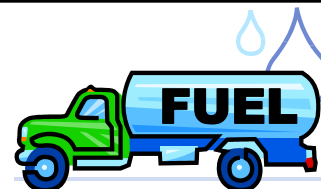
