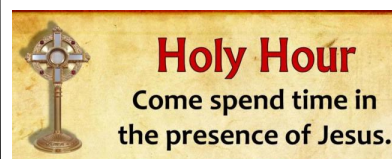

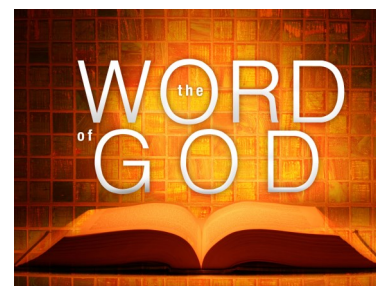

Today's Scripture

18th Sunday in
Ordinary Time

2 Kings 4:42-44 Ephesians 4:1-6
John 6:1-15

*Jesus was a great prophet.
He truly proclaimed in word and deed
the greatness of the mercy and love of God.*

The multiplication of loaves and fishes has sometimes been described as being a social miracle; that Jesus shared all the food he had and people were impressed by his generosity and they shared all the food they had. This is a beautiful story, but it is not what is found in today's Gospel account.

This is a nature miracle—one in which Jesus changes the rules of nature. This idea is reinforced by the fact that Jesus goes out for a walk on the Sea of Galilee in the next passage of the Gospel and he then calms a storm—both of which are also nature miracles. Miracles can and do happen, both in Jesus' day and in our own.
