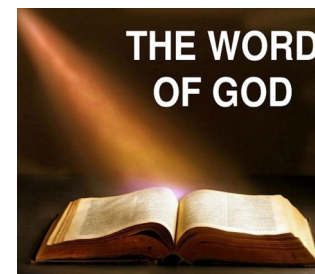

Today's Scripture

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b
Ephesians 5:21-32 John 6:60-69

Peter made a profession of his faith in Jesus at the end of the Discourse on the Bread of Life.

The 2nd reading has two major themes. The first teaching is based upon Stoic philosophy. Stoics believed that there was a proper order to all things.

Unlike most Stoic teaching, however, the passage also speaks about the obligation of husbands to love their wives. There are mutual obligations to honor and support each other.

Would the author of this letter phrase his teaching the same way today? Was the teaching that women should be subordinate an eternal truth, or was it based upon cultural understanding of what God wanted?

The teaching on marriage is very positive. Unlike Saint Paul's teaching in Corinthians that one should marry to avoid temptation, this letter teaches that marriage is a foreshadowing of the union between Christ and the Church. It is so much more positive, in fact, that many scholars wonder whether Paul actually wrote this letter.

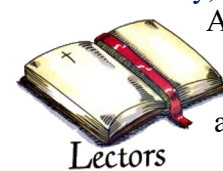

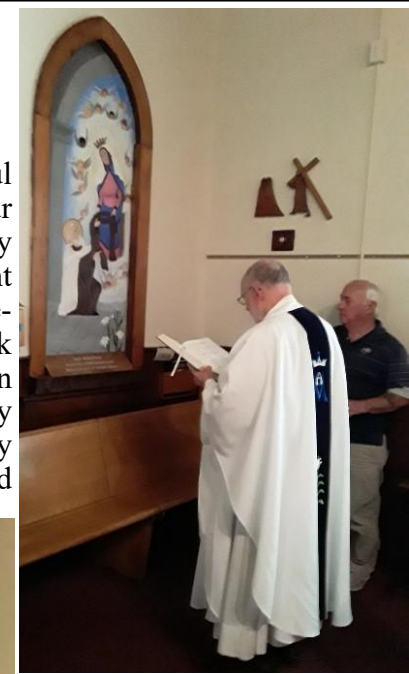

symbol for Carmelites.

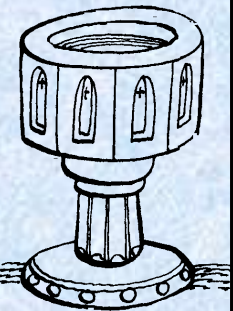
Ted has been working on the painting for the last several weeks. We are so very appreciative, Ted!
