Today's Scripture Readings



7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23 1 Corinthians 15:45-49 Luke 6:27-38

We are called to a new standard of conduct, one based upon love for our brothers and sisters.

Saint Paul uses the imagery of Jesus being a second Adam in today's passage from First Corinthians. The first Adam, the first human created, is our forefather. He brought sin into the world. We have inherited this (original sin) from him,

The second Adam, Jesus, has brought life into the world. Unlike the first Adam, he was obedient to the command of his Father. While we have inherited our earthly nature and sin from the first Adam, we have inherited our spiritual nature and the hope of eternal life from Jesus.
