

14th Sunday in **Ordinary Time**

Galatians 6:14-18 Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

The word of Christ will transform us.

It will bring us a peace that nothing can take away from us.

Saint Paul chose to follow the Lord with heart and soul. This meant not only saying "yes" to the Lord; it meant also rejecting all those things that would get in the way (this is what it means to be crucified to the

We are a new creation (for with the death and resurrection of Jesus, all things are made new). We cannot return to the old ways that just dragged us down.

When Paul says that he bears the brand marks of Jesus, he is using the Greek word "stigmata." This does not mean that he bore the wounds of Christ (as Saint Francis did). It probably refers to the scars of scourgings and beatings.
