### About the Liturgy: Law, Love, Life

Jesus challenges us in the Gospel Reading today to go beyond the minimum requirements of the law and respond to others in love. At the same time, the whole purpose of the law is to lead us to a deeper life. All our deeds and works, as we seek to fulfill the law, must aim at promoting love and life in the world.

God is constantly moving about in the world (that's the beauty of our doctrine of the Incarnation!) and so must be always open to the presence and work of God. While we build our worship each Sunday on a clear and solid framework established by Church Law, our liturgy must also be living and dynamic, just as God is actively dynamic in His relationship with us. Hence, the ultimate criterion of a liturgy is not so much as how it has made me feel, as how it leads me to promote love and life among those who surround me. God's spirit breathes life and love into those who are faithful to the spirt of the law that engages us to look beyond the mere act of following rules.




